

Art HoCo 2009

a biennial juried exhibition

Juror: Amanda Burnham, Assistant Professor and Area Coordinator of Foundations, Towson University

eligibility All artists, 18 years or older, residing, working, or studying in Howard County, are invited to submit up to three works completed in the last two years, and not previously shown in HCAC galleries. All media will be considered. All work must fit through a doorway measuring 54" x 80" and fit appropriately in the HCAC gallery. Maximum height is 9' 6".

entries Artists may submit work as slides or on CD, one slide/file for each 2D work and two slides/files for each 3D work. Slides/CD will be returned only if accompanied by a self-addressed, stamped envelope. **Slides:** Slides must be 35mm and labeled with artist's name, title of work, and the top front of the slide must be indicated by writing "top". Any tape must be inside the mount. **Digital:** Digital entries must be individual files in jpeg (.jpg) format only, on a CD labeled with the artist's name. Label each file with the artist's last name, first initial and title or portion of the title of the work (SmithA_Untitled.jpg). Files should be 300 ppi and 8" (or 2400 pixels) in the longest dimension. Unless submitting film- or video-based work, video or digital presentations (including PowerPoint) cannot be accepted.

entry fee A non-refundable fee of \$20 is due with this application. *HCAC members can apply at no cost; individual artists may join for \$30 and waive entry fee.*

awards A minimum of \$500 will be awarded by the juror.

sales A 20% sales commission will be retained by the HCAC on all sales. Work will be sold at the price listed on the entry form. Work not for sale should be marked "NFS."

presentation All work must be received ready for installation with proper hanging devices and instructions where necessary. HCAC reserves the right to refuse any piece for any reason.

liability All works are insured against physical damage or loss by HCAC from receipt through designated pick up date and time. An insurance value must be included for all entries.

agreement The decision of the juror is final. *All accepted works must remain for the duration of the exhibit.* Slides of the accepted entries become the property of HCAC, which reserves the right to photograph accepted works or use the slides/CD for publicity and educational purposes. HCAC reserves the right to reject works not suitably presented or that differ from the slide. Submission of an entry constitutes an understanding and agreement with all of the conditions set forth in this prospectus.
